



2004 RIESLING – MUSEUM RELEASE

A new re-release from our Cellar for winter 2009, this wine won a GOLD Medal at the Royal Sydney Show – the first time we had entered one of our wines. It is the wine that propelled our Riesling into the Langton's Classification of Australian Wine and received many accolades when initially released. Jancis Robinson included it in her *"Festive Season Wish List 2009 - 20 White Wines from around the World"* ...in London's FT - the only Australian wine in the line-up might we add!

At six years of age this gem is still amazingly youthful, fresh and bright. A very tightly structured wine, the colour is very pale green/gold and the nose is intensely minerally and subtly aromatic. Poised and restrained, the palate is beautifully fine with steely, racy acidity seamlessly in tune with its soft, round mouthful of stoney minerality, spice – and a whiff of fresh lime. It's better drunk only slightly chilled and will continue to mature gracefully with careful cellaring.
